Patriot Medal Nomination Form

The Patriot Medal is awarded only by a state-level society and may be presented only to an individual. It represents long, faithful, and outstanding service at the state and/or chapter level. Service at the national level is not considered during the process. It is preferred that the medal be presented at the annual meeting of the state-level society. A representative cannot accept the Patriot Medal.

- All requirements should be thoroughly reviewed before requesting this medal. The state is responsible for ensuring that they keep a record of all past recipients and that it is annotated in the individual's awards section in the NSSAR database so as to avoid any duplicate awards.
- The Patriot Medal may be awarded annually by any state-level society. Societies with fewer than 500 members may present no more than one medal each calendar year. Societies with 500 to 1,000 members may present two medals each calendar year. Societies with over 1,000 members may present one medal for each 500 members.
- An SAR member may receive this medal only once. Oak leaf clusters or other ribbon attachments are not authorized.
